



Supra HF100

This is the only cable whose manufacturer, Jenving Technology AB/Supra Cables is publicly-listed by HDMI LLC as an adopter. The company deals with HDMI directly when it comes to having its cables certified, submitting its products to an authorised testing facility.

Hailing from Sweden, Supra makes high-grade interconnects for upmarket AV equipment. And the HDMI 1.3a-certified HF100 reflects the minimalist design typically associated with such gear with its 10mm-diameter light blue cable and shielded HDMI plugs attached with 'military-spec' soldering. Jenving claims that the gold-plating applied to the pins of

the plugs is as thick as 0.8 micrometres for longevity and reliability of connection. The cable itself has been designed for longer runs (6m versions are available) and indeed Jenving's website suggests that 20m runs are possible. Within that, blue cables are four screened twisted pairs of OFC solid core conductors, which are spaced by a polyethylene (PE) foam dielectric. In accordance with HDMI recommendations, double screening is employed to minimise the likelihood of RFI. Our 1m sample worked as expected with signals from 576i to 1080p (complete with multichannel digital audio) being conveyed without glitches or drop-outs.
