£35 buys you disproportionate improvements across the board – although some systems will prefer a lead that swaggers less at the top end

THERE ARE STILL doubters, but proof of the boost dedicated mains leads can give your system does exist – thanks in part to companies like Supra.

The LoRad is one of the most cost-effective upgrades you can make. If you're using freebie mains cables with your kit, the improvements will be revelatory. Music gains extra drive and pace, plus more insight into performances – vocals are more natural and solid, and movies look more stable and detailed. Upper frequencies may become a little brazen but, really, there's no excuse not to upgrade if you want to see and hear the best of your system.
